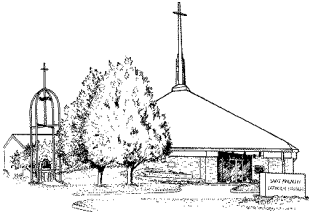

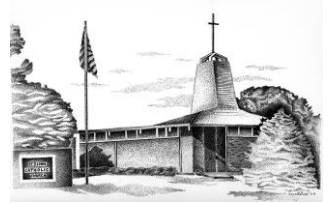

The Babbling Bruch

Joy creeps into the readings this week. We are closer to the moment when God takes on a human identity, becomes flesh, and dwells among us. God becoming human casts new light on our own identity.

Both Isaiah and John the Baptist wrestle with questions of identity. How about taking time to check on our own identity?

Before discovering our identity, it is necessary to wade through what we've been told about ourselves from early on. What untruths about my own identity linger in my heart, blocking knowledge of who I really am; a beloved child of God?

John said he was a voice. How would you describe yourself? A voice? A heart? An ear? An open hand? An iron fist? A backbone? Both Isaiah and John claimed to have been sent by God. In what way do you feel sent? To do what? To be what? Are you living your true and intended identity?

In this season of darkness John testifies to the light. How might you testify to the light in your words and actions? Where can you point to the light of Christ radiant in your family and parish life?

St. Paul urges that people "test everything" and keep what is good. How open are you to testing new ideas? How confident are you that you know what is worth keeping and worth tossing?
