Building-Renovation Update

The Bldg/Reno Committee has been hard at work as we move forward with the parish hall project. Sub-committees have been formed and are working on identifying the current needs of the parish. Many parish members have been called on to help with this work. We hope to have worked through this process by the first part of spring and be ready to meet with the architect/contractor for the building design process. As always, this all takes time, and remember our committee members are volunteers. Our goal is to be ready to begin sometime in the spring of 2020. In order to accommodate the new building plan, we have met with the city of Boone and have received permission to close the south end of the alley between 12th and 13th streets. Bazaar Update

A big thank you to everyone who helped make our annual Bazaar a great success. Total Income was \$11,277.26, Total Expenditures were \$3059.30, for a Net Profit of \$8217.96. We served 320 adult meals and 74 children's meals which is up 15% from last year. This is the first positive trend in many years and our profit was up \$1,934.22 from last year. Again, many thanks to all who donated, served and attended the Bazaar this year!
